

Notice Concerning Vital Records 1921-1925

The Massachusetts Registry of Vital Records and Statistics has recently transferred birth, marriage, and death records for the years 1921-1925 to the Massachusetts Archives. We are currently working to make these records available in a digital format. In the meantime, the vital record volumes for the years 1921-1925 are only available for on-site research.

If you are interested in obtaining a copy of a vital record from the years 1921-1925 and cannot visit the Archives in person, you should request a certified copy through the US Mail. The cost for each certified copy is \$3.00US payable by cash, check, or money order. Please include a separate check for each certificate requested. Researchers may order a maximum of five certificates may be ordered at one time and must wait for receipt of copies from their initial order before submitting a new request. If we are unable to locate the record you have requested we will return your payment.

Checks can be made payable to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
