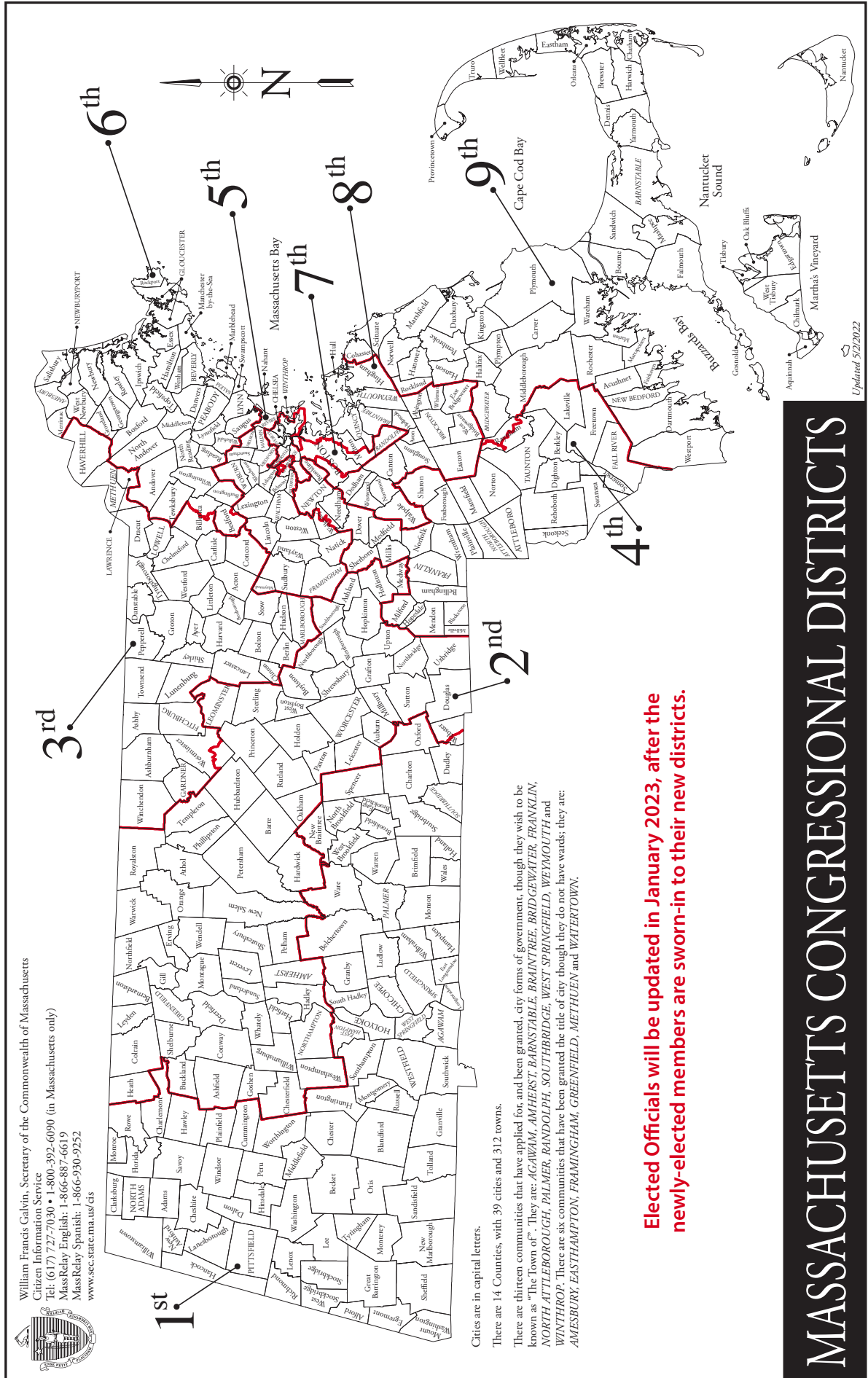

 There are thirteen communities that have applied for, and been granted, city forms of government, though they wish to be known as "The Town of". They are: **AGAWAM, AMHERST, BARNSTABLE, BRAINTREE, BRIDGEWATER, FRANKLIN, NORTH ATTLEBOROUGH, PALMER, RANDOLPH, SOUTHBRIDGE, WEST SPRINGFIELD, WEYMOUTH and WINTHROP**. There are six communities that have been granted the title of city though they do not have wards; they are: **AMESBURY, EASTHAMPTON, FRAMMINGHAM, GREENFIELD, METHUEN and WATERTOWN**.

Elected Officials will be updated in January 2023, after the newly-elected members are sworn-in to their new districts.
