Notice is hereby given pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, § 3 that the Massachusetts Historical Commission intends to amend the following regulations:

**PROTECTION OF PROPERTIES INCLUDED IN THE STATE
REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES (950 CMR 71.00).**

The amendment seeks to provide a time for initiation of the consultation process upon a determination of adverse effect pursuant to M.G.L. c. 9, § 27C.

There will be a thirty day public comment period concerning the proposed amendment.
