V. Any additional notes on perceived causes of discrepancies:

The difference in number of ballots is likely due to hand-count errors during the audit. The difference in number of blank ballots is due to the following: one early voting ballot was marked in red pen so it was read as blank by the machine (both races). One ballot had the O in the word "No" filled in instead of the oval and during the hand count this was changed to a vote for "No" instead of blank. Another ballot had the "NO" oval circled instead of filled in. The differences in the counts for Clinton and Trump are likely hand-count errors during the audit.
