**V. Any additional notes on perceived causes of discrepancies:**

For each race, it appears that 6 ballots were counted differently, or 0.26% of the total number of ballots cast. This may be due to errors in hand counting during the audit. Or, it may have been caused by voters mis-marking the ballots. Our audit found 12 ballots where the voter used a check mark, 9 ballots where the voter used an X, and 7 ballots where the voter only partially filled in the oval. If the mark was entirely within an oval it was probably read correctly.
