NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON REGULATIONS

The Office of Campaign and Political Finance (OCPF) will hold a public hearing concerning proposed revisions to regulations at 970 CMR 2.00 relative to the use of campaign funds for adult-care services expenses as authorized by Chapter 9 of the Acts of 2025. The regulations will be issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 55, § 3; G.L. c. 30A; and Section 133 of Chapter 9 of the Acts of 2025.

The public is invited to comment on the proposed regulations, which will be posted on OCPF's website, www.ocpf.us at least three weeks prior to the hearing. Testimony may be presented orally at the public hearing in person or remotely via a teleconferencing platform. The hearing will be held on Thursday, October 9, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at the office of OCPF, One Ashburton Place, Room 411, Boston, Massachusetts.
