SUMMARY ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST

Based upon a preliminary investigation conducted by the staff of the Pennsylvania Securities Commission (Commission), the Commission has determined that evidence exists to support the following findings and conclusions:

- 1. Urban Power USA, Inc. (Respondent Urban) was, at all times material herein, an entity with an address at 180 Pleasant Street, Easthampton, Massachusetts 01027. At all times material herein, Respondent Urban was purportedly in the business of manufacturing and selling low wind turbines and was offering for sale common stock (Stock) in Respondent Urban;
- 2. Mark Maynard (Respondent Maynard) was, at all times material herein, an individual with addresses at 180 Pleasant Street, Easthampton, Massachusetts 01027 and 16 Fairfield Avenue, Easthampton, Massachusetts 01027. At all times material herein, Respondent Maynard was the CBO of Respondent Urban;
- In or about July 2011, at least one Pennsylvanis resident (PA Resident) observed an advertisement (Ad) posted on an Internet message board. The Ad stated that Respondent Urban is offering for sale 10% of its Stock for a total offering of \$500,000. The Ad provided a link to a website at www.urbanpowerusa.com (Website);

- 4. In or about July 2011, the PA Resident observed the Website, which stated that \$50,000 investments in Stock are available for \$5.00 per share. Using a "Contact Us" form provided on the Website, the PA Resident requested additional information about investing in the Stock;
- 5. In or about July 2011, Respondent Maynard e-mailed the PA Resident and stated:
 - a. Respondent Urban has a "current offering for 10 units [of Stock] of 10,000 shares each, for a total of 100,000 shares of [Stock]";
 - b. "Each unit of 10,000 shares is offered at \$5.00 per share of equity investment for a total of \$50,000 per unit"; and
 - c. "Each unit presents [sic] 1% of the [Stock] authorized";
- 6. In or about July 2011, Respondent Maynard e-mailed offering materials (Materials) consisting of a business plan to the PA Resident. The Materials state that Respondent Urban is a manufacturing company formed "to commercialize a revolutionary wind turbine invested by...[Respondent] Maynard" and is seeking to raise approximately \$500,000 from private investors for 100,000 shares of Stock to expand operations;
- 7. In or about July 2011, the PA Resident telephoned Respondent Maynard, who stated:
 - a. Respondent Maynard has invented a wind turbine and has applied for and obtained approval for a patent for the turbine;
 - b. Respondent Maynard has decided to include investors in order to make the company larger;
 - c..... Respondent Urban is offering 10 units of Stock at a price of \$50,000 per unit;
 - d. \$50,000 is the minimum investment, but a partnership could be formed for a group to reach \$50,000; and
 - e. Any investments had high possibilities for returns but investors should not expect a return on investment for about five years;

- 8. In or about September 2011, the PA Resident received additional Materials consisting of a "Stock Purchase Agreement" which states that Respondent Urban has authorized the sale of 5,000 shares of Stock and is selling the Stock for \$5.00 per share;
- The PA Resident had no substantive, pre-existing relationship with Respondent Urban or Respondent Maynard;
- 10. The PA Resident was not an accredited investor under Rule 501 of Regulation D, and did not have sufficient knowledge and experience in financial and business matters to be capable of evaluating the merits and risks of the investment; and
 - 11. Neither the Ad nor the Website contains the disclosure set forth in Commission Regulation 203.190, 64 Pa. Code § 203.190.

WHEREAS, the Stock described above is a "security" within the meaning of Section 102(t) of the Pennsylvania Securities Act of 1972 (1972 Act), 70 P.S. § 1-102(t); and

WHEREAS, Respondent Urban is the "issuer" of the Stock described above within the meaning of Section 102(1) of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. § 1-102(1); and

WHEREAS, Respondent Maynard acted as an "affiliate" of Respondent Urban within the meaning of Section 102(b) of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. § 1-102(b); and

WHEREAS, the records of the Commission disclose that the Stock is (a) not registered under Section 201 of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. § 1-201; (b) not exempt from registration under Section 202 of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. § 1-202; and (c) not a federally covered security; and further, the securities transactions relating to the Stock are not exempt under Section 203 of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. § 1-203; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Commission finds that Respondents Urban and Maynard have engaged in and are about to engage in acts and practices which violate Section 201 of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. § 1-201; and

WHEREAS, after due deliberation, the Commission finds that it is necessary and appropriate, in the public interest, for the protection of investors and is consistent with the purposes fairly intended by the policy and provisions of the 1972 Act to issue the following Order:

NOW, THEREFORE, by the authority of Section 606(c.1) of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. § 1-606(c.1):

IT IS ORDERED that Urban Power USA, Inc. and Mark Maynard, and every successor, affiliate, control person, agent, servant, and employee of them, and every entity owned, operated, or indirectly or directly controlled or hereinafter organized by or on behalf of them, shall immediately CEASE AND DESIST from offering and selling the Stock in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in violation of the 1972 Act, and in particular, Section 201 thereof.

Pursuant to Section 607 of the 1972 Act, 70 P.S. §1-607, within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notification that this Order has been issued, any Respondent(s) against whom this Order was issued and entered may file with the Secretary of the Commission a written request for a hearing in respect to any matters determined by the Order. This written request must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission at the Commission's Harrisburg office. Failure to timely file the request for a hearing will result in this Order becoming a final Order.

Upon receipt of such written request for a hearing, the matter will be set down for a hearing to commence within thirty (30) days after receipt unless the person making the request consents to a later date.

If a person making a request for hearing consents to a later date but fails, after notification by first class mail to the person's last known address in the Commission's files, to consent to a hearing date that is within 180 days of the request, the request for a hearing shall be deemed abandoned and the order shall be deemed a final order.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS ORDER MAY RESULT IN CRIMINAL PROSECUTION, INJUNCTIVE PROCEEDINGS, CIVIL CONTEMPT PROCEEDINGS, (INCLUDING CIVIL MONETARY PENALTIES) AND, SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF HEARING AFFORDED RESPONDENT UNDER THE 1972 ACT, THE IMPOSITION OF ADMINISTRATIVE MONETARY ASSESSMENTS AND STATUTORY BARS.

Urban wind power: Giving new meaning to the windy city

EASTHAMPTON - The term "wind power" conjures up images of massive blades on tall shafts out in the ocean, atop a mountain or on a prairie. City resident Mark Maynard's invention could change that. Maynard's vertical-axis wind turbine is designed for urban environments - on the roofs of skyscrapers, factories and even apartment buildings. The turbine is lightweight and silent, can capture smooth or choppy winds, requires little maintenance and has a low profile. Most important in the world of alternative energy production, it's affordable, capable of paying for itself in as little as 30 months.

"I think we have a very good advantage in the marketplace," Maynard said Tuesday, while overseeing the installation of a prototype turbine on the roof of the Paragon Arts and Industry Building on Pleasant Street. "I do believe this can be game-changing." That 2-kilowatt aluminum turbine, which can create enough electricity to power several homes, looks more like an industrial rooftop heating and cooling apparatus than it does any sort of windmill. It would cost about \$7,000, Maynard said.

The prototype turbine will stay on the Paragon Building for about a month, allowing Maynard to measure wind conditions and how much energy the turbine is creating. It is not currently powering the building or attached to the grid. The prototype is 8 feet in diameter and 4 feet tall. A slightly larger 5-kilowatt version is only weeks away from completion, Maynard said. And they can get much bigger from there. A turbine with a 50-foot diameter could produce 100 kilowatts, said Maynard, who has a second patent pending on the design for the larger models.

The turbines could also be stacked atop one another, allowing for efficient use of rooftop space. Maynard is hoping his turbines will change the way that urban dwellers and businesses consume electricity. "This is designed to capture low wind speeds, turbulent wind and wind that comes between buildings," he said. The device would allow its owner to take advantage of net metering - sending electricity to the power grid and pulling it back out as needed, saving money and reducing the user's carbon footprint in the process.

Maynard, who works for the Springfield Water and Sewer Commission, began working on scaled foam models of the turbine four years ago in his living room. He has three grown children and is pursuing a degree in management and engineering at UMass Amherst.

Maynard and his business partners, Michael Garjian and Kimela Webb, are seeking investors to fund the production of the turbines. Maynard, who has dipped into his retirement savings to fund startup costs, said he is speaking to several investors. The three are in the process of incorporating Urban Power USA, which can be found at www.urbanpowerusa.com. They have also applied for a grant to help the city put turbines on one or more city buildings.

Mayor Michael A. Tautznik looked on Tuesday as a crane installed the turbine. "It's just intriguing," Tautznik said. "It should be exciting for everyone when we consider the kind of power we use as a nation." Tautznik

introduced Maynard to Garjian, an inventor himself, several months ago when he heard about Maynard's project. Garjian has worked in the alternative energy industry since 2000. He founded Vegetable Energy Group LLC, which makes heating pellets, in 2005 and was recently appointed chairman of the board of directors for Sustainable Power Corp., a biofuels provider. Garjian said that he will be using his contacts in the alternative energy world to market and produce Maynard's turbines. "There is nothing like this," Garjian said. "We can go into a city and put these on skyscrapers."

Winds of Change

In keeping with one of the City of Easthampton's expressed goals of remaking the former manufacturing town into a regional pioneer in renewable energy production, the municipality can now point to a local company that is working to make low-cost wind energy technology available to anyone who wants it. Urban Power USA, Inc. plans to begin the research phase of field trials for its first

product, a 10-foot commercial

wind turbine for smaller



buildings, using a patented vertical turbine model that's easily adaptable to urban rooftops, and may eventually be made viable for residential use as well.

The company, located on Pleasant Street, hopes to expand its production as well as offer other, bigger versions of its product (to commercial entities that have the rooftop space to support them). Urban Power USA projects that it will add more than 100 jobs in the next two years.

In a written statement on its website, Urban Power USA sets out its goal of "promoting low cost environmentally friendly wind generated electricity to all people," saying it will "contribute a portion of corporate profit to local and regional communities for social reinvestment and share its profits with its employees."

One of its main goals is to keep power affordable. The company notes that wind power's cost per kilowatt hour is expected to be the cheapest source of energy for decades to come; Urban Power USA's most compact model (8 feet in diameter and costing about \$7,000) produces up to 2 kilowatts and can pay for itself in less than three years. Larger models (such as the UT-10) are 16 feet in diameter and can produce up to 12 kilowatts of power. The units are also capable of being wired into net metering devices that allow the power producer to sell excess electricity back to the grid.

The nascent corporation is the brainchild of turbine inventor and Easthampton resident Mark Maynard and business partners Michael Garjian and Kimela Webb. Largely founded with Maynard's retirement savings, the company is currently vying for grant money to place some of the turbines atop Easthampton city buildings, with the aid of Easthampton Mayor Michael

Urban Power USA is actively seeking both investors and a local business with appropriate rooftop space available to further test the potential of its products-offering to "make significant financial considerations in return for collected data and testimony of performance." The company's website also features something of a tutorial on how a group of residents in an apartment or condominium building might go about forming their own power co-op by jointly purchasing a unit, placing it on the building's rooftop and sharing the power that's produced among their various residences.
